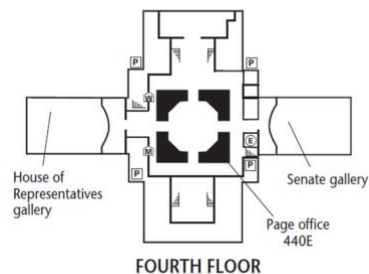
- 2) **Legislative Committees** – KSlegislature.org lists each House and Senate Committee and the time they are meeting and their room number:
